## ***PAINTING: METHODS AND MEANING WITH ANDY FABO***

In this master painting class led by senior Toronto artist Andy Fabo, participants will explore the postmodern strategy of layering, producing a complex, constructed space in their composition. Beginning with a presentation on the evolution of this approach to artmaking, participants will be introduced to a variety of gel transfer, collage and acrylic painting techniques. Beginner and intermediate levels of experience are welcome. Andy Fabo is a Toronto artist, art critic, curator and art educator. He has exhibited nationally and internationally, including a retrospective at the Museum of Contemporary Canadian Art in 2005. He has published essays and reviews in Canadian periodicals as well as numerous exhibition catalogues, and has taught at the Toronto School of Art and various Ontario universities. His paintings and drawings are in museum collections across Canada.
